

SAFE BATTERY USAGE (con't)

- Use only the type of battery recommended for the unit.
- Batteries should be replaced only by an adult.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix different types of batteries or old and new batteries.
- Use alkaline batteries for best performance and longer life.
- Do not short-circuit batteries.
- When not used for an extended time, remove batteries to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
- Do not mix rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be recharged only under adult supervision.
- Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire as they may leak or explode.

NOTE: The voltage of a fully-charged, rechargeable battery is often lower than that of a fresh alkaline battery. Therefore, it is recommended that alkaline batteries be used instead of rechargeable batteries for best performance and for longest play time.

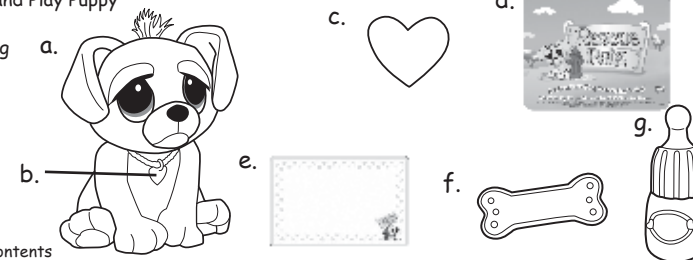
INTRODUCTION

This little Rescue Pet acts just like a real puppy - he really drinks water, burps, and then lifts his leg and pees! Plus he chews on his bone and sits or stands on command.

CONTENTS

Welcome your Rescue Pet to your home by making sure the package contains:

- a. 1 Rescue Pets™ Train and Play Puppy
- b. 1 Collar Tag
- c. 1 Sticker For Name Tag
- d. 1 Adoption Certificate
- e. 1 House Training Mat
- f. 1 Dog Bone
- g. 1 Water Bottle

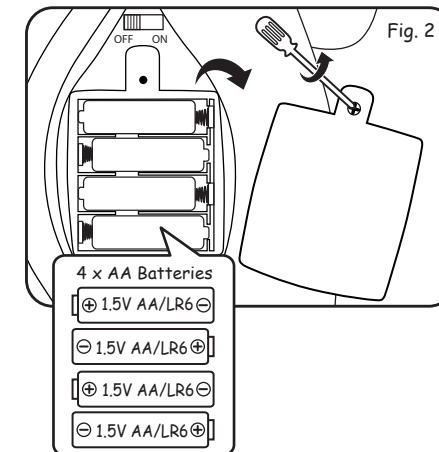
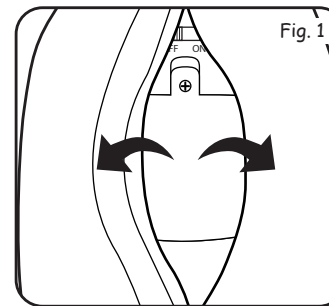

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Battery installation and replacement should be performed by an adult.

1. Pull open the plush opening located at the back of the pet. (Fig. 1).
2. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment cover. (Fig. 2).
3. Insert four (4) 1.5V AA batteries (not included) with the positive (+) and negative (-) ends facing the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and tighten the screw.
5. Move the "ON/OFF" switch to ON.
6. Close the Plush back opening to cover the battery box area.



QUICK START

SITTING, STANDING AND SPEAKING

1. If your Puppy is in a sitting position, clap your hands once and he will rise into a standing position. (Fig. 3)
2. If your Puppy is in a standing position, clap your hands once and he will go back into a sitting position. (Fig. 4)
3. Clap your hands twice and your Puppy will sit on his hind legs, raise and lower his front paws, and bark!

FEEDING TIME

Dog Bone:

1. Put the Dog Bone into the Puppy's mouth. (Fig. 5)
2. The Puppy will lean forward and make chewing noises with the bone in his mouth. (Fig. 6)
3. After about 3 - 4 seconds, the Puppy will stop chewing and rise back up into a sitting position.
4. Take the Dog Bone out of the Puppy's mouth.

Water Bottle:

1. Unscrew the cap of the Water Bottle counter-clockwise and lift it off.
2. Fill the Water Bottle to the fill line marked "MAX" with clean, clear water.
3. Replace the cap on the Bottle.
4. Hold the Puppy up with your hand on the back of his head.
5. Place the tip of the Water Bottle into the Puppy's mouth. Push the bottle down firmly, then squeeze it gently to help your Puppy drink. He will begin to make drinking noises and really drink the water! (Fig. 7)

NOTE: When holding the Puppy this way, do not touch his tail, otherwise you will activate his pee function!

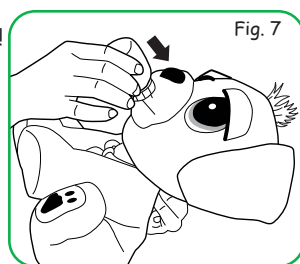
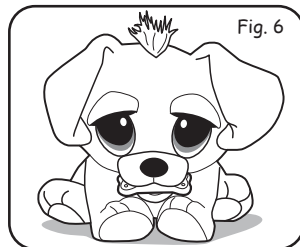
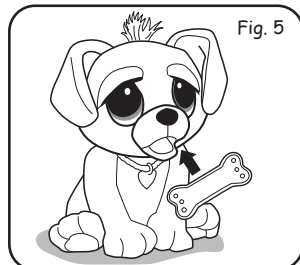
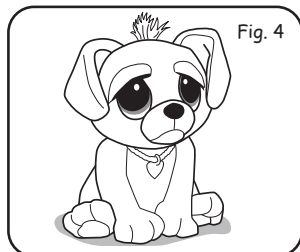
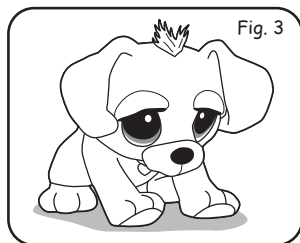
6. After 3 - 4 seconds, the Puppy will finish drinking and will burp when the bottle is removed from his mouth.
7. If you give your puppy too much water, the overflow will pour out of his mouth.

⚠ CAUTION: NEVER give the Puppy any liquids other than clean, clear water as this can cause irreparable damage!

NATURE CALLS! (PEE FUNCTION)

Uh-oh! Puppy drank too much water and now he has to pee! Help train him to go on the training mat and not on your expensive new Persian rug! To do this:

1. Place the House Training Mat underneath your Puppy's hind legs.
2. Gently squeeze the base of the Puppy's tail. (Fig. 8)
3. The Puppy will stand up and raise his hind leg three to four times. Each time he lifts his leg, a small stream of water will come out.
4. Any water that hits the House Training Mat turns the Mat blue!
5. After 3 - 4 seconds, the Puppy will go back into his sitting position.



QUICK START (con't)

NOTE: Sometimes the Puppy has to lift his leg a few times before water comes out.

NOTE: It is recommended that you add a paper towel underneath the House Training Mat for better absorbency.

SLEEP MODE

If the Puppy is not played with for 60 seconds, he will quietly go into Sleep Mode. To resume play, simply squeeze his tail or place the Bone or Bottle in his mouth.

ADOPTING YOUR RESCUE PET

TROUBLESHOOTING

- If the motion of your Rescue Pet Train and Play Puppy becomes slow and/or the voice becomes weak, replace the batteries with fresh AA Alkaline batteries.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Training Mat:

After play, allow the Training Mat to air dry in a well ventilated area. Do not wipe the Training Mat with a cloth or tissue as permanent color damage may occur to the Training Mat.

Train N' Play Puppy:

Make sure that you empty all of the water out of your Train and Play Puppy before you store it. Do this by squeezing the base of the Puppy's tail repeatedly until no water comes out.

NOTE: If the Puppy is turned upside down when water is inside, some water will leak out through the mouth.

To clean your Pet, brush it with a cloth or soft brush to loosen any dirt. Then use a slightly damp cloth to remove any stains.

IMPORTANT:

The Puppy and Training Mat will get a little wet during play. Allow them to air-dry in a well-ventilated area after play. Also, be sure to follow these important rules:

- DO NOT put your Pet or Training Mat into the washing machine.
- DO NOT use detergent or stain removers on the Pet or Training Mat.
- DO NOT submerge your Pet or Training Mat in water or expose them to heavy moisture.
- Wipe dirt off immediately to prevent stains.
- DO NOT put the Pet or Training Mat into a dryer or dry them with a blow-dryer.
- If the Pet is accidentally immersed in water, remove the batteries immediately and let the Pet air dry. Once the Pet is dry, replace the batteries.
- Do not store the Pet for long periods of time without removing the water and batteries.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

⚠ CAUTION:

- DO NOT sit or stand on any part of the Pet.
- Avoid spilling food or beverages on the Pet.
- DO NOT throw or kick the Pet.
- DO NOT push sharp objects through the speaker openings.
- DO NOT submerge Pet in water.
