

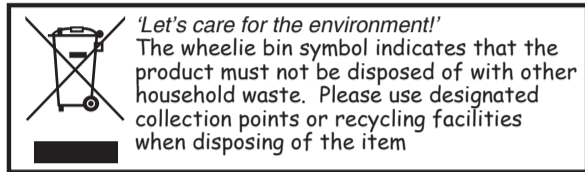

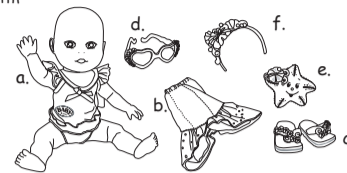
ADULT BATTERY INSTALLATION REQUIRED

INTRODUCTION

BABY born® is a natural swimmer! Just place your BABY born® - Mommy, Look I Can Swim doll in the water and she'll begin kicking her legs and really swimming!

CONTENTS

- 1 BABY born® - Mommy, Look I Can Swim! Doll with Swim Suit
- 1 Slip-on Mermaid Tail
- 1 Pair of Flip-Flop Sandals
- 1 Pair of Sunglasses
- 1 Starfish Water Toy with Squeaker
- 1 Headband

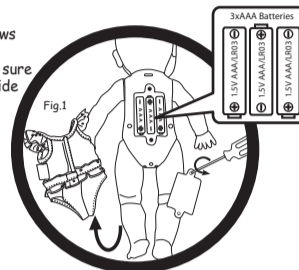

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Before going into the water, ask an adult to help install batteries.

1. Remove BABY born's outfit to reach the battery compartment.
2. Using a Phillips head screwdriver (not included), remove the 2 screws and battery compartment cover.
3. Install three (3) 1.5V AAA alkaline batteries (not included) making sure that the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment. (Fig. 1)
4. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the 2 screws securely to ensure a watertight seal.
5. Put BABY born's outfit back on. She is now ready to go swimming!



REPLACING BATTERIES

- Dry BABY born® thoroughly before opening the battery compartment.
- If moisture is present in the battery compartment, dry it with a towel.
- Install the new batteries as instructed above.

QUICK START

Start by picking up BABY born® and giving her a big hug. As BABY born's "Mommy", there are many different things that you can do to take care of her, such as:

- Take BABY born® swimming.
- Give BABY born® a Bath.
- Amuse BABY born® with her Starfish friend.

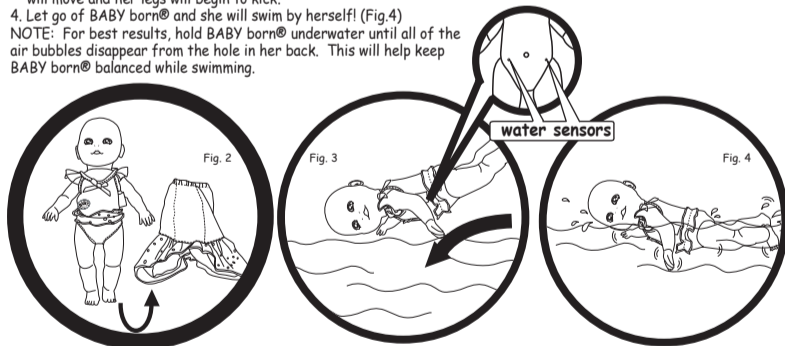
SWIMMING OR BATHING WITH BABY born®

Your BABY born® - Mommy, Look I can Swim! Doll is waterproof. You can take her in the water with you! If you do, here are some tips to keep BABY born® happy and healthy:

WARNING: Constant, competent adult supervision is REQUIRED when children are playing around water.

Swimming:

1. Remove BABY born's Mermaid Tail, Sunglasses, Flip Flops and Headband before entering the water. You wouldn't wear them in the pool and neither should she! (Fig. 2)
 2. Move BABY born's head to the side and outstretch her arms in a swimming pose. (Fig. 3)
 3. Gently place her into the water tummy-first. As soon as the water touches sensors on her front, her arms will move and her legs will begin to kick.
 4. Let go of BABY born® and she will swim by herself! (Fig. 4)
- NOTE: For best results, hold BABY born® underwater until all of the air bubbles disappear from the hole in her back. This will help keep BABY born® balanced while swimming.



Important Notes:

- Do not keep her in bath, salt or chlorinated pool water for long periods of time as discoloration or bleaching may occur.
- Do not apply any make-up or skin care products (like sunscreen) to BABY born®.
- When bathing, use only cold or lukewarm water and mild soap products for children.

NOTE: BABY born® must be cleaned and dried after bathing. Please refer to the CLEANING BABY born® section at the end of this manual.

WARNING: Do not use BABY born® as a floatation device!

SQUEAKING STARFISH

BABY born® comes with a cute water toy. This toy also has a secret surprise - it can squeak and squirt water!

1. Pinch the sides of the Starfish and hold it completely underwater. (Fig. 5)
2. Stop pinching the Starfish and let it soak up the water. (Fig. 6)
3. The Starfish is ready to squirt water! (Fig. 7)



NOTE: DO NOT point the squirting Starfish at people, pets, furniture or other vulnerable objects.

CLEANING BABY born®

IMPORTANT: After play, drain excess water from the hole on BABY born's back, dry the doll thoroughly and bring indoors. Prolonged exposure to sunlight will cause damage to BABY born®.

If BABY born's skin looks dirty, wipe her with a clean, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaning solutions or other harsh chemicals. Leave her in a well-ventilated space to dry.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Adult supervision REQUIRED when children are playing around water.
- NEVER use any of BABY born's accessories with a real baby!
- Please follow all instructions in this manual when playing with BABY born® in water.
- Be sure to clean BABY born® after going in the water, otherwise she might develop mold or mildew.
- If an allergic reaction occurs due to contact with the doll, seek medical attention immediately.

If BABY born® will not be played with for extended period of time, remove the batteries to prevent possible corrosion and damage to the toy.

- DO NOT allow children to play in water that is near an electrical source or apparatus in order to avoid electric shock and/or electrocution.
- DO NOT leave BABY born® near an electrical source or apparatus when wet.
- DO NOT place BABY born® in extremely hot or extremely cold water.
- Not recommended for outdoor use.

SAFE BATTERY USAGE

- Use alkaline batteries for best performance and longer life.
- Use only the type battery recommended for the unit.
- Batteries should be replaced only by an adult.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix different types of batteries or old and new batteries.
- Do not short-circuit batteries.
- When not used for an extended time, remove batteries to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
- Do not mix rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be recharged only under adult supervision.
- Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire as they may leak or explode.

NOTE: The voltage of a fully-charged, rechargeable battery is often lower than that of a fresh alkaline battery. Therefore, it is recommended that alkaline batteries be used instead of rechargeable batteries for best performance and for longest play time.
